Nearly 110,000 people died of a drug overdose in 2023 and about 75% of those deaths involved an opioid. Fentanyl, currently the deadliest drug available, can be found in all street drugs, including marijuana, THC oil, cocaine, and methamphetamine. The Lehigh Valley is greatly affected by the fentanyl crisis and we all have a part to play in reducing harm and saving lives. Education is an important weapon in the fight against substance misuse.

<u>Caring for Creation Tips</u> for reducing use of plastics Did you know that most plastics you recycle still end up in a dump in another country, or in the ocean killing sea life? We now all have microplastics in our bodies due to over use of plastics. Here are some ideas to reduce your use.

- One Brita bottle with a filter replaces cases of bottled water. A filtered pitcher or faucet mounted or whole house filter costs less than a year's supply of bottled water.
- Put taking reusable grocery bags at the top of your grocery list.
- Replace detergent bottles with sustainably packaged pods for laundry, hand soap, DW.

Available online from Dropps, Grove Collective (carries multiple cleaning and personal care products, with all recyclable containers and locally from the FD market at Promenade shops. FD market also sells refillable shampoo, shampoo bars, non-plastic toothbrushes.
