## A Word from Pastor Linda Wisser:



#### The STAR Monthly Newsletter: Final Edition

In 1957, Dwight Eisenhower was president of the United States. The average median family income was \$5000. "Leave it to Beaver" was among the top ten shows on television. Buddy Holly and the Crickets released their smash hit, "That'll Be the Day", and the first portable electric typewriter was placed on sale in Syracuse, New York. It was also the year that East Hills Moravian Church was chartered in Bethlehem, PA and the first edition of The Star monthly newsletter was published. Much has changed since 1957.

One of the most apparent shifts in our lives has been in communication. In 1957 and for the decades that followed, the mailing of the monthly church newsletter was the primary way EHMC members would know what was happening the life of the church. It was quite a production, with teams of people enjoying each other's company as they served each month to assemble the pages and prepare for bulk mailings. In the last decade, the bulk mailings were no longer necessary as most members opted to receive the news via email and only a few received it in the mail. Still, The STAR averages 12-15 pages of printed material and often takes 12-15 hours each month for office staff to produce, even in email format.

Recently our Communications Team noted that the STAR pre-dates our weekly Thursday email blast, and it contains most of the same news we share every Thursday. Church news is also shared in various other ways, such as pre-service PowerPoint projections on Sundays, on the screens in the narthex daily, bulletins, on Facebook, and on our church website. With all these things considered, the Joint Board has decided to discontinue producing and distributing the monthly STAR Newsletter.

We understand that changes are not always easy and that for some, this change may not be quickly embraced. But please be assured that if you currently receive the Thursday news in the mail, you will continue to receive those weekly mailings. And things such as the monthly calendar and birthday list found in the STAR will be in the Thursday news on the last Thursday of each month. We are excited to utilize effective, modern ways to communicate and to adapt our use of the resources God gives us for the work of ministry!


TREX recycling: The bagging dates are May 12<sup>th</sup> & 26th.


